

Q: What is the Memorial Page?

A: The Memorial Page is a website dedicated to honour the memory of deceased loved ones who have received care at BC Children's Hospital and BC Women's Hospital & Health Centre BC.

Q: Who can submit to the Memorial Page?

A: The legal guardian(s) of the loved one who has received care at BC Children's Hospital or BC Women's Hospital & Health Centre BC can submit a memorial.

Q: Can there be more than one submission per memorial?

A: For each memorial, only one submission from the legal guardian(s) is accepted.

Q: Does it cost anything to submit?

A: There is no cost to submit to the Memorial Page.

Q: What can I submit?

A: We recommend that you submit your loved one's full name, date of birth and date of death. In addition you may wish to submit a photo, a drawing and/or written words (in the form of a letter, poetry, song lyrics, prayer, some of your thoughts etc.) that express and honour cherished memories of your loved one. Please keep written material to 500 words or less. If a submission is longer than 500 words, please be mindful that you will be asked to edit it before posting. You may also include a link to an outside webpage (ie., Facebook or other memorial webpages).

NOTE: If you are submitting a photograph of your loved one, please ensure that there are no other people in the picture in order to avoid confusion or issues of confidentiality.

Q: How do I submit?

- A:**
1. Click on the email link on the Memorial Page. The link will open an email automatically addressed to Linda Wollschlaeger-Fischer from Spiritual Care at: LFischer@cw.bc.ca.
 2. Type or copy your text into the body of the email and attach a picture (optional) and send the email. Remember to clearly state the name of the person whose memory you are honouring.
 3. Linda Wollschlaeger-Fischer from Spiritual Care will review your submission and then have it posted to the website. Linda will contact you via email if there are any concerns regarding your submission.
 4. Your memorial submission will be posted as soon as possible. You will need to check the Memorial Pages to see if your submission has been posted.

Q: How long will the submission stay on the Memorial Page?

A: The submission will remain on the site for as long as the BC Children's Hospital and BC Women's Hospital & Health Centre BC website is up and running, or until the legal guardian asks us to remove it.

Q: Can I submit text in another language on the Memorial Page?

A: Yes but please provide a translation of the text with your submission.
