

Longer Term Parking Options

For those coming to the hospital often, we offer the following parking passes through our ATM-style pay stations:

- 1-week pass \$35
- 1-month pass \$55

Insert your “parking entry ticket” into the machine to start the menu. Pay with cash or credit card. VISA and MasterCard accepted.

There are two other passes that are available for families:

- Family one-day “green sticker” pass \$4.50 per day

This one day parking pass is with the Preferred Accommodation package. Please note this is only valid for one day of parking. If you leave the site more than once, you will need to purchase another parking pass or pay at the cashier booth when you leave.

- Family 30-hour pass \$50

You can purchase this pass at the cashier’s office in the BC Women’s Hospital main lobby from 8 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. weekdays. This multiple hourly pass is for people who must make many clinic visits. The maximum daily charge is five hours and the pass is valid until the time is used up.

RV Parking

There are three RV parking spaces for immediate family members of admitted patients. These must be reserved three business days in advance. RV parking is generally limited to four weeks. The fee includes parking for your RV plus one vehicle. Reserve by calling (604) 875-2086.

- RVs parked without prior authorization may be towed at the owner’s expense.
- RVs and vehicles are parked at the owner’s risk.
- A vacant site does not mean the site is available.

Once you have a reservation, you can purchase your RV passes from a pay station.

- One night \$15 (purchase from staff at parking booth)
- One week \$105 (purchase from automated pay station)
- One month \$265 (purchase from automated pay station)

Please display your parking pass on the dashboard or front window of your RV.

Parking Enforcement

All parking lots are patrolled and to make sure the designated areas are used appropriately. If you are a patient or patient family member and you receive a ticket for parking in a “Patient Only” space, please contact the parking supervisor or mail in your ticket with the explanation. We will cancel tickets issued by mistake.

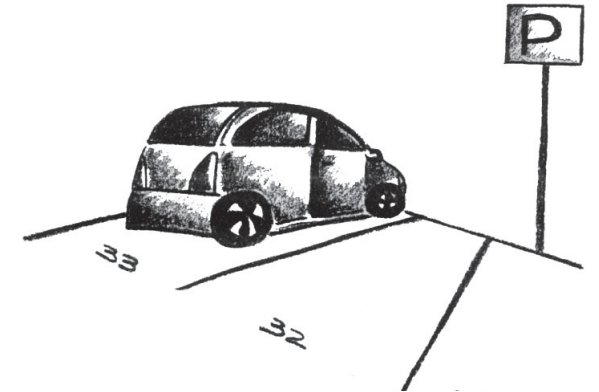

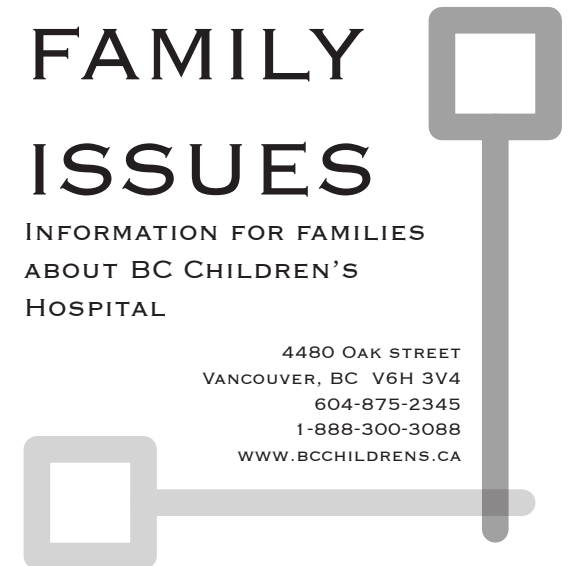

Paying for Parking

Five new “ATM style” automated pay stations located throughout the site allow you to prepay and avoid any lineups at the cashier. You’ll have 15 minutes to exit the site once you have prepaid.

There are three cashier booths located at the main entrances.

“Patient Only” Parking Locations

Reserved for patients only from 8 a.m. – 2:30 p.m weekdays

There are 300 “patient-only” spaces reserved between 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. These are our busiest times. Finding a parking space can be tough. Please arrive early for your appointment to get there on time.

Ambulatory Care Building

- east end of building: 89 spaces (5 handicapped stalls)
- in front of L block (across road from the Ambulatory Care Building main entrance): 9 spaces (5 handicapped stalls)
- one-hour parking meters for patient drop-off and pick-up only: 42 (2 handicapped stalls)

BC Children’s Hospital main building

- underground parking: 73 spaces (7 handicapped stalls). Clearance in the underground parking lot is only 2 metres.

Emergency Department

- 7 patient parking spaces (2 handicapped). Please register your vehicle at the Emergency Department reception desk.

BC Women’s Hospital

- underground parking: 9 spaces (4 handicapped stalls) Clearance in the underground parking lot is only 2 metres.
- main entrance: 38 spaces (2 handicapped stalls)
- Labour & Delivery (Admitting) entrance: 7 spaces

BC Women’s Health Centre

- across from main entrance: 6 spaces with 3 hour limit (4 handicapped stalls)

Family Practice/Breast Screening

- on east ring road: 14 spaces including 2 spaces for Screening Mammography (2 handicapped stalls)

Mental Health Building

- northeast corner 38 spaces (2 handicapped stalls)
