As part of the ongoing work of Building Bridges, a provincial initiative aimed at improving service provision for women impacted by abuse, substance use and/or mental ill health, the Woman Abuse Response Program of BC Women’s Hospital and Health Centre will be hosting a workshop and consultation for those working throughout the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority region. The workshop will be held on June 3-4, 2009 in North Vancouver. Day one will host an evening Speaker Series followed by a full day workshop and consultation on day two. This workshop is part of a coordinated attempt to improve service provision through effective and integrated work across the sectors.

This workshop will provide opportunities for frontline service providers and managers within the health, addictions, mental health and anti-violence sectors to explore how these issues intersect to create risks to women’s health and safety and add barriers to accessing services. Attendees will have the opportunity to share their perspectives and experiences on challenges, gaps, and barriers in service delivery and make recommendations on how to develop an integrated provincial approach to improve services for women impacted by these intersecting issues.
