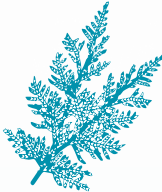


PPSUP EDUCATION AND TRAINING OFFERINGS

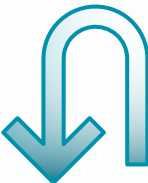
