Donation guidelines

- Due to infection control and allergies, we are **not able to accept used items** of any kind. This includes stuffed/plush animals.
- We ask that donations are not gift wrapped.
- Please do not donate toys or action figures with weapons or violent themes.
- Due to privacy and infection control guidelines, we cannot accommodate personal delivery of donations to patients.
- Occasionally, we receive items that may not be appropriate for us in the hospital. These items are shared with other children's charities in the Lower Mainland.

Clothing

We accept new clothing (with tags) for all ages, and most often need items for teenagers and adults:

- Underwear and socks
- Comfortable, loose-fitting clothing: leggings, sweatpants, t-shirts, sweaters

Toiletries and comfort items

- Travel-sized shampoo, conditioner, soap, lotion, lip balm, mints
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste
- Hairbrushes
- Deodorant

Games and activities

- Sensory items:
 - Fidget toys (Pop It)
 - Squishy stress balls (NeeDoh)
 - Chew toys
 - Weighted toys/blankets
