Our service compliments the Indigenous Patient Liaison service. The Indigenous Complex Care team is comprised of a Nurse and Social Worker. The team works with patients and families who have complex needs and will require extra support after leaving the hospital.

The team works together to help plan the process of returning home from hospital and follows up with the plans and progress you have made once you return home. This new service is slowly phasing in on the units and clinics of both BC Women's and Children's Hospitals.

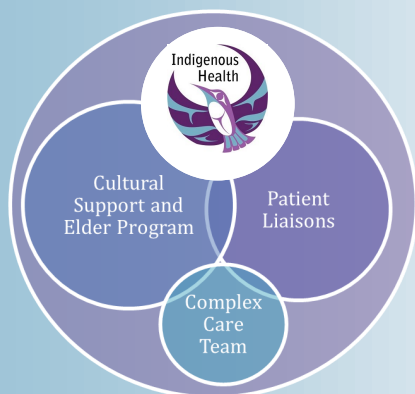
