

Early Pregnancy Assessment Clinic

The Early Pregnancy Assessment Clinic (EPAC) offers assessment of early pregnancy complications, diagnosis, and management of early pregnancy loss. We also provide supportive counselling and follow up care. The EPAC is staffed by registered nurses and an obstetrician/gynecologist.

Who is eligible?

We support people who:

- 1 are more than 6 weeks pregnant but less than 10 weeks + 6 days pregnant (by gestational age) and are cramping or bleeding **OR**
- 2 have a non-viable pregnancy confirmed by ultrasound at less than 12+6 weeks gestational age.

How do referrals work?

EPAC accepts self-referrals. If you wish to self-refer, please call 604-875-2592 weekdays 9am to 3pm. After hours, you may leave a message and we will contact you directly within 1-2 business days.

If your pregnancy care provider will refer you to our clinic, please have them **fax** a referral with all relevant information and reports to 778-504-9761.

When to seek emergency care

If you have heavy bleeding, dizziness or fainting, severe abdominal pain, or a confirmed ectopic pregnancy you should go to your local emergency department.
